Generator Detail

Design: Onan 2-pole self-excited revolving field Permanently aligned to engine by a tapered shaft Drip-proof construction

Insulation System and Temperature Rise: Meets ANSI/RVIA EGS-1, BS-4999 standards, and CSA 946 standards

GenSet Performance

Air Conditioner Operation:

60 Hz: at 500 ft. (152.4 m and 100°F (38°C:). The 2.8 KV genset will start and run one approved 13500 BTU air conditioner (14.7 cooling amps or less) plus a 600-watt baseload, or one approved 11000 BTU air conditioner plus a 1000-watt baseload. The 2.5 KV genset will start and run one approved 13500 BTU air conditioner plus a 300-watt baseload. **50 Hz:** at 500 ft. (152.4 m) and 100°F (38°C). The 2.0 KV will start and run one 7800 BTU air conditioner (5.5 cooling amps or less) with a 300-watt baseload.





Operating Temperature Range

Gasoline sets will operate from -20°F (-29°C) to 120°F (49°C). LPG sets will operate from 0°F (-18°C) to 120°F (49°C). LPG set starting and operation below 32°F (0°C) depends upon LP tank capacity, surface area and butane content of LPG.

Warranty Policy

The Limited Warranty covers virtually everything except routine maintenance for the first two years you own your RV generator, and covers parts and labor on major power train and generator set parts during the third year. In addition, it also includes a free 90-day adjustment policy, which provides that Onan will make minor adjustments to your new genset during the first three months you own it - free of charge! Please note: The Onan 3-year Limited Warranty applies to RV generators used in RV applications only, and does not apply to RV generators used in commercial mobile applications.
